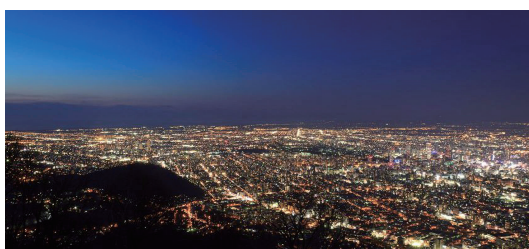

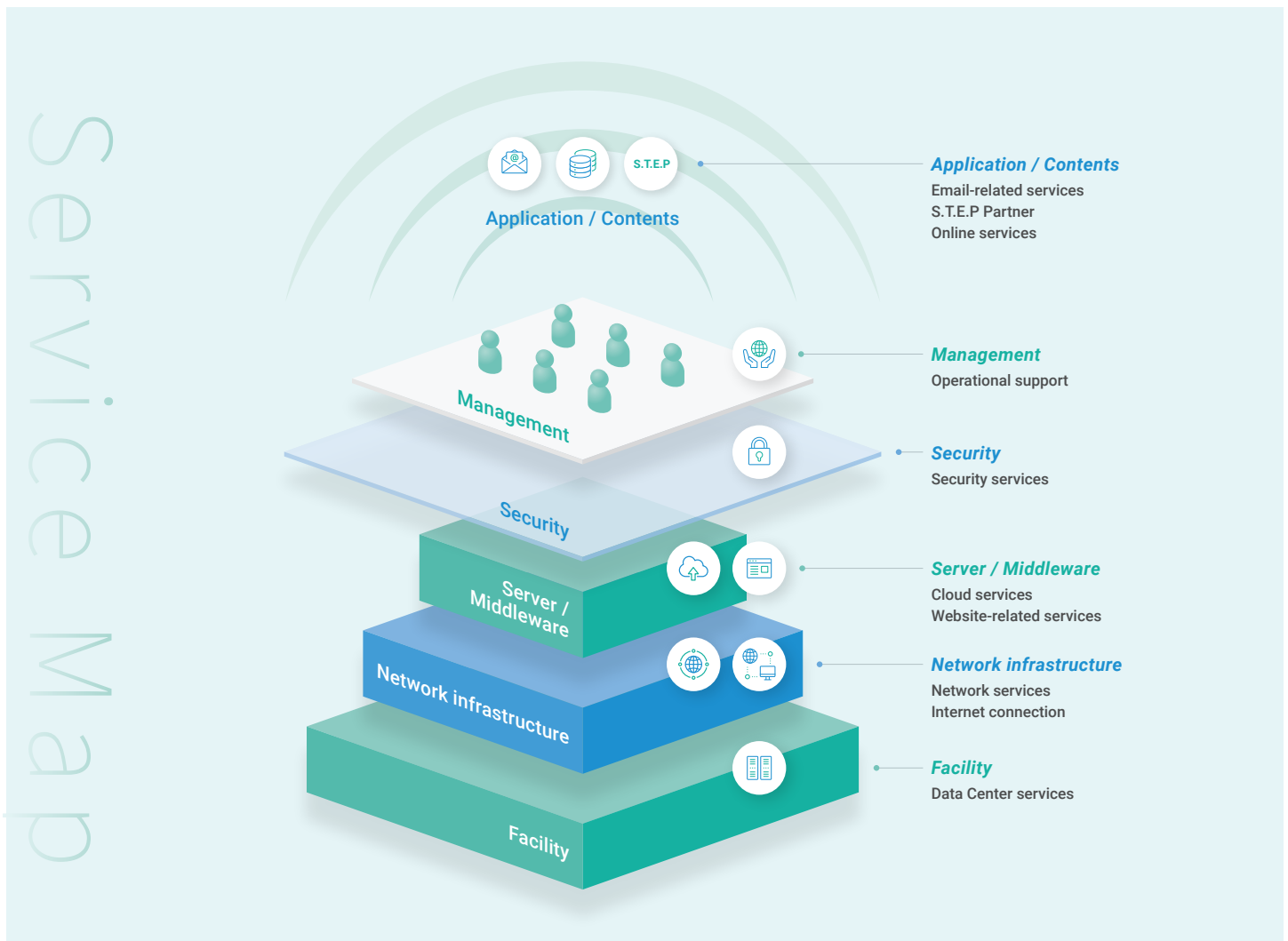
■ The PNJ Group

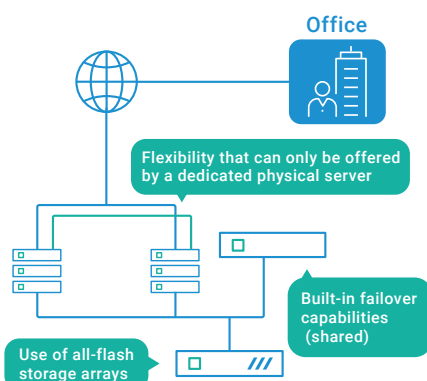

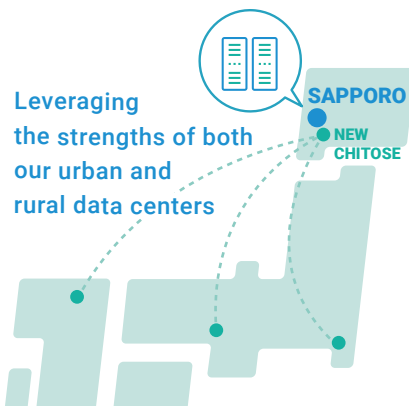

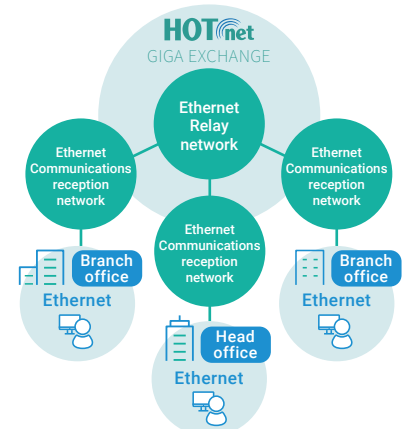
